Return to school on the 4th January 2022

As the Headmaster announced in his email on 8th December, distance learning will be implemented for the school's pupils on 4th and 5th January. All students will be expected in person on 6th January.

On the first day back between 8:30 and 8:45 am, each teacher will send an email to the families in their class giving access to the pupils' Padlet of work.
