Dear Parents

The parents' letter is back and you will receive it every month. I will use it to share the major events of the school and to remind you of important information. It will be sent by email, but will also be accessible on the Lycée's website.

SCHOOL HOURS

Every morning, the Bordars Road school gate is open between 8.20 and 8.45am.

All pupils make their way to their class between 8.30 and 8.40 am. Maternelle pupils are accompanied to their classroom. Elementary pupils leave their parents in the drop off/pick up area and make their way directly to their classroom where the teacher awaits them.

In the evening, maternelles are picked up in the cloakroom at 3.30pm (1.10pm on Wednesdays).







CP, CE1 and CP/CM1 are picked up in the parents' drop off/pick up area at 3.35pm (1.15pm on Wednesdays). CE2, CM1, CM2 are picked up in the parents' drop off/pick up area at 3.40pm (1.20pm on Wednesdays).

LATE ARRIVALS AND ABSENCES

For the smooth running of the school and the safety of your children, please thoroughly respect drop off and pick up times.

In case of absence, please inform the school by email (first thing in the morning of the first day of absence) and indicate the reason for the absence. BURSARIES

The second application process for 2021-2022 has opened during the summer. The initial deadline of 17/09/2021 for applications **has been postponed to 24/09/2021** in order to allow families wishing to apply to do so in due time.

Following the updates on British guidance in August 2021, the sanitary protocol for the schools has been modified.

Child with symptoms

A child with a Covid symptom will have to stay at home, or leave the school, and take a PCR test.

Test results

If the test result is negative, the child can return to school.

If the test result is positive, the child will have to self-isolate. NHS Test and Trace will set the end of isolation date. The teacher will inform you of the work done in class, within 48h for core subjects (French, Maths and English). There will be no marking. The teacher will take special care when the child returns to school.

Contact cases

The NHS Test and Trace will identify contact cases and liaise with families. Schools are not part of the Test and Trace process anymore.

<u>British guidance</u> state that: "Individuals are not required to self-isolate if they live in the same household as someone with COVID-19, or are a close contact of someone with COVID-19, and any of the following apply:

- they are fully vaccinated
- they are below the age of 18 years and 6 months
- they have taken part in or are currently part of an approved COVID-19 vaccine trial
- they are not able to get vaccinated for medical reasons

Instead, they will be contacted by NHS Test and Trace, informed they have been in close contact with a positive case and advised to take a <u>PCR test</u>. We would encourage all individuals to take a PCR test if advised to do so.

Staff who do not need to isolate, and children and young people aged under 18 years 6 months who usually attend school, and have been identified as a close contact, should continue to attend school as normal. "

Isolation for contact cases is not systematic anymore. However, given the risk of contagion, I kindly ask that you please take a precautionary approach to preserve the school community. Our joint prudence and efforts will make the difference.

Wearing face-coverings is recommended for adults entering the school.

We will inform you when there is a positive case in your child's class.







HEALTH PLAN

For pupils who need particular care or a medical treatment, a health plan must be put in place (PAI). For this, please contact the school doctor (pmomeni@lyceefrancais.org.uk).

Packed lunches will not be authorised without a health plan.

Without a health plan, no medicine will be administered to a child by any member of staff.

Under no circumstances, can a child carry medicine at school.

SCHOOL PHOTOS

Mrs Roche will be in the school from 27th to 29th September to take individual portraits and class pictures. The detailed schedule and a message from the photographer will be sent to you a few days before.

LOST PROPERTY
