ENGLISH

English teachers have spent this first week of the new school year carrying out assessments so they know how to best cater for each pupil. This has included an oral assessment for all pupils in MS, GS and CP, a reading assessment for all pupils in CE1 as well as a general assessment of reading, comprehension and writing for all new pupils in CE2 - CM2 and pupils who were with Miss D last year. English and DNL lessons commenced on Friday 10th September.

COVID PROTOCOL

A message was sent to you by email on Thursday September 9th, with details of the new protocol resulting from the latest British Guidance update. The information below summarises it.

If your child has symptoms, they should self-isolate and have a PCR test. If the test result is negative, the child can return to school. If the test result is positive, the child will have to complete his period of self-isolation. Parents will be notified of the self-isolation date end by NHS Test and Trace. Their parents will be informed by the teachers, within 48 hours, of the key work done in class (French, Mathematics, English). There will be no corrections. Special attention will be given by the teacher when the child returns to class.

The NHS Test and Trace will contact the family of the child, to identify with whom the child has been in close contact. Schools are no longer part of the Test and Trace process. Self-isolation of close contact cases is no longer automatically applicable; children and young people aged under 18 years 6 months should continue to attend school as normal.

We will keep you informed when a child tests positive in your child's class as well as any recommendations issued by Public Health England (PHE) with whom we are in regular contact. Due to the contagiousness of the virus, it is imperative that we continue to take all necessary precautions to preserve the health of our school community.

MORNING CHILDCARE AND AFTERSCHOOL ACTIVITIES

The company "[Loisirs à l'Ecole](#)", which organises afterschool and Wednesday afternoon activities, has resumed in accordance with the School's health protocol.

The morning daycare is operational again from 8:00 a.m. This is a paid service. The [registration form](#) is available on the Lycée's website.

ELECTION FOR PARENT REPRESENTATIVES

School Council Meetings take place three times a year. These serve to adopt the school's internal rules and to give its opinion on questions relating to the functioning of the school. Parents are represented by 15 elected members.

Elections for parent representatives for the "Conseil d'école" (School Council Meetings) will take place from October 19th to 21st. Information will be sent to all families before the elections. The first meeting will be held on Tuesday, November 16th.
