## INFORMATION FOR CM2 PARENTS REGARDING 6<sup>ème</sup>

At the start of 2022, when re-enrolling for next school year, CM2 parents will be invited to indicate their choice of section for their child in 6<sup>ème</sup> (plurilingual section or international section), as well as their choice of modern language (LV2).

They can already find, on the Lycée's website, a presentation of 6<sup>ème</sup> and the language courses in secondary (see link opposite). A videoconference meeting will also be organised for parents **on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> December 2021 at 5.15 p.m.** This meeting will be led by secondary school management staff. An invitation email will be sent shortly.

## TELETHON AND CHILDREN IN NEED

Once again this year, South Kensington School will participate in Téléthon and Children in Need, two important charity days for our two countries. The two associations will be presented in class ahead of these days.

Téléthon: a children's book fair will be organised on **Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> November** in the playground by CM2C pupils, thanks to donations from families. Pupils will run stalls for their classmates from CP to CM2, who may come and buy books of their choice at the set price of £1.

Children in Need: students from CP to CM2 will be able to deposit coins in a piggy bank available in classes from Monday 29<sup>th</sup> November to Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> December. To mark the event, **Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> December will be "Spotty Friday!"** Children will be invited to come to school that day in polka-dot clothes, if they wish.
