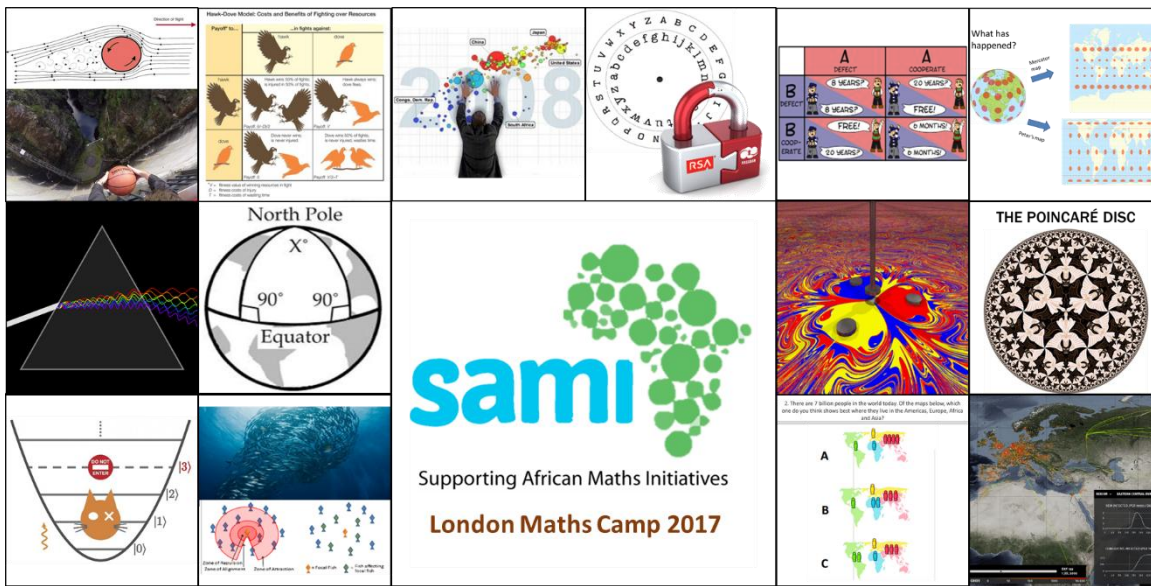


SAMI London Maths Camp 2017

SAMI is excited to announce its third annual Maths Camp in London, hosted at the Lycéé Français Charles de Gaulle, South Kensington from 13th to 17th February 2017.



What's it all about?

SAMI is a charity based in the UK that has been working around the world to help foster a love and appreciation of maths, and its role in society. The London maths camp is week-long event that brings together students, teachers, lecturers and maths enthusiasts from all walks of life, in shared exploration and discovery of ideas which stretch far beyond the traditional school curriculum. It is also an opportunity to reach out and help those who otherwise might not get such experiences in life.

Pupils will be exposed to lectures by the likes of Professor Balazs Sendroi from Oxford University, Professor Jose Antonio Carillo De La Plata from Imperial College London and Professor Bruce Hobbs from the University of Edinburgh. Topics for the week include big data, internet encryption and modelling the physical world.

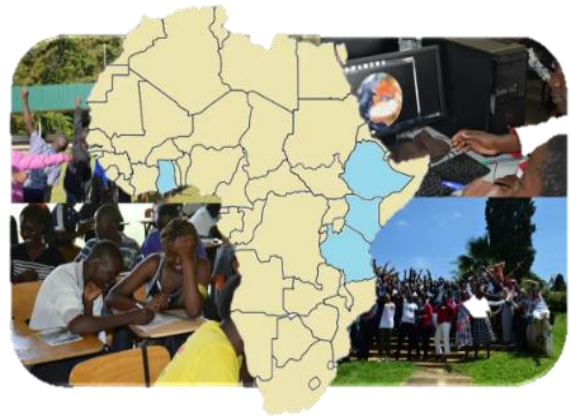


Supporting African Maths Initiatives

Background Info

Mission

There are huge divides in terms of access and quality of education across Africa. Mathematics in particular proves problematic for students and teachers alike, falling far short of global standards. There is however no shortage of passionate, enthusiastic and talented individuals in these countries with powerful ideas to improve the current state of education. SAMI was founded in 2013 as a means to support these local initiatives, and provide the expertise and funding necessary to implement, sustain and scale these ideas. By working directly with local people and organisations that have support and contacts within mathematics education, SAMI is well positioned to help deliver high impact solutions where they are needed most.







Our Projects

SAMI supports much ongoing work across Africa, including coordinating volunteers and resources to help run yearly maths camps in Kenya, Ghana, Ethiopia and Tanzania, as well as weekly maths clubs in over 70 schools. SAMI has also helped to raise money and lend expertise to developing computer programs for statistics and education, as well as providing tablets and training to help improve livelihoods for people living in rural African villages. With some extra funding SAMI could extend their programmes to more schools and communities in more countries, and travel to the most isolated areas where their support is needed most.

At the London Maths Camp everyone is volunteering their time so all proceeds can go to support SAMI projects. Attending the maths camp in London will not only benefit the students who attend, but will help students across Africa.
