Dear Parents

Please find below the back-to-school information.

- The school year will start on Wednesday 3 September 2025 for all classes.
- The official opening and closing times, as set out in the 2025-2026 school rules, will apply from Wednesday 3 September.

Maternelles (Petite Section-Moyenne Section-Grande Section)

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday: 8.30am - 8.40am to 3.30pm Wednesday: 8.30am - 8.40am to 1.10pm

Elementary:

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday: 8.30am - 8.40am to 3.40pm Wednesday: 8.30am - 8.40am to 1.20pm

- On the first day of school, please observe the timetables and procedures specified in this document.
- On the morning of Wednesday 3 September, class lists will be posted in the parents' courtyard and in front of the classrooms on the garden side.
- Parents of pupils whose child has a PAI are asked to contact the secretariat before the start of the school year to check that the protocol is up to date for the start of the school year (medicines available at the school, date of validity of medicines and prescriptions up to date, etc.).
- With the exception of Petite Section pupils, all pupils will have lunch in the canteen from the first day.

BACK TO SCHOOL IN NURSERY

Nursery parents will be allowed to accompany their child to class throughout the year.

In Moyenne Section, all pupils will start on Wednesday 3 September:

- Pupils whose surname begins with the letter A to G will start at 8.30 am.
- Pupils whose surname begins with the letter **H** to **Z** will start at **8.45 am**.

On the first day of school, classes will finish for all Moyenne Section pupils at 1.10pm . Children will be collected by an adult at the classroom door.

In Grande Section, all pupils will start on Wednesday 3 September:

- Pupils whose surnames begin with the letters A to E will start at 8.30 am.
- Pupils whose surnames begin with the letters F to Z will start at 8.45 am.

On the first day of school, classes will end for all Grande Section pupils at **1.10pm**. Children will be collected from their classrooms by an adult.

In Petite Section, all pupils will return on Wednesday 3 September:

- Children with a surname starting from A to L will have class from 8.30am to 9.45am (Group A)
- Children with a surname starting from M to Z will have class from 10.40am to 11.55am (Group B)
- For the first week, children will be picked up at their class' door at the times indicated in the table below.

START OF ELEMENTARY SCHOOL (CP to CM2)

All elementary pupils will start school at 8.30 a.m. on Wednesday 3 September.

On the first day of school, parents of elementary pupils will accompany their children to their respective classrooms at 8.30 am. Teachers will take charge of pupils as they arrive. Parents will inform the teachers of the name of the adult who will collect their child on the first day. For the rest of the year, only parents of nursery pupils are authorised to accompany/pick up their child(ren) from the classroom.

Class ends at 1.20pm.

Pupils will be collected from the parents' playground by the parents or a designated adult.

A FEW RECOMMENDATIONS

All entrances and exits (pupils and parents) must go through the Bordars Road gate (parallel to Laurie Road).

Only members of staff are permitted to use entrance 44 Laurie Road and to park their vehicles in the car park inside the school.

All children will have lunch at school, including Wednesday lunchtimes. As supervision cannot be provided after school leaving time, parents must make all arrangements to ensure that their children are picked up at school leaving time. Furthermore, the school secretary cannot be asked in advance by parents to supervise their child(ren).

All nursery pupils must be accompanied to and collected from the classroom door by a person nominated by the parents (form included in the information form). The same applies to elementary school pupils in the parents' playground.
